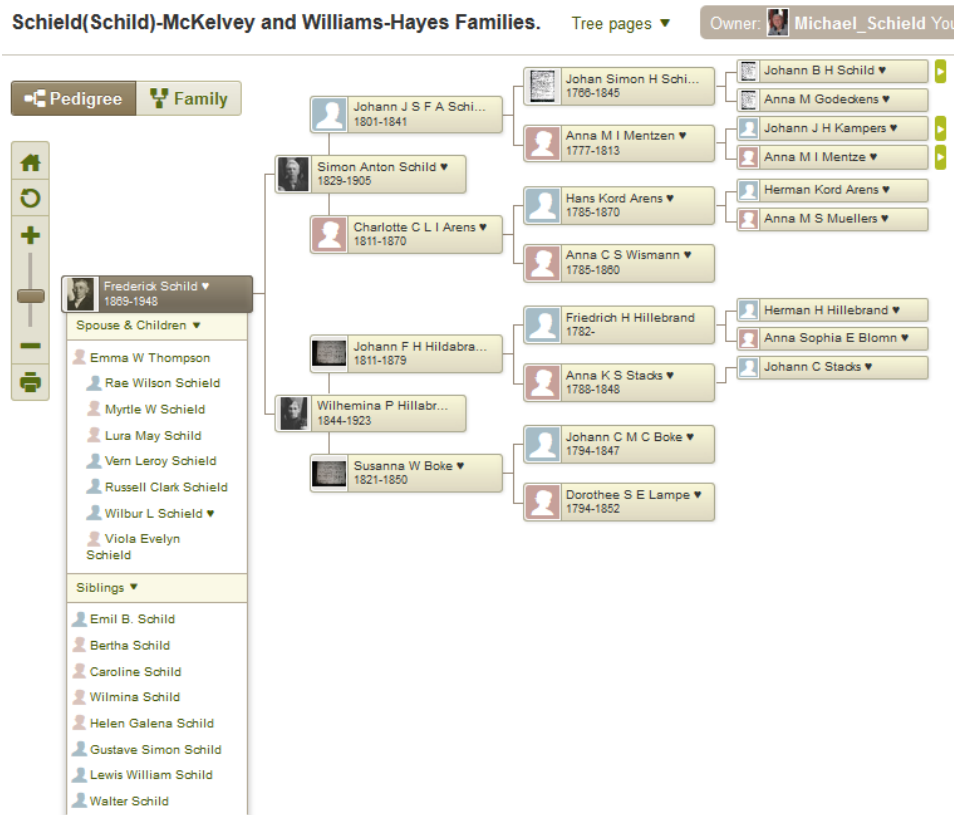

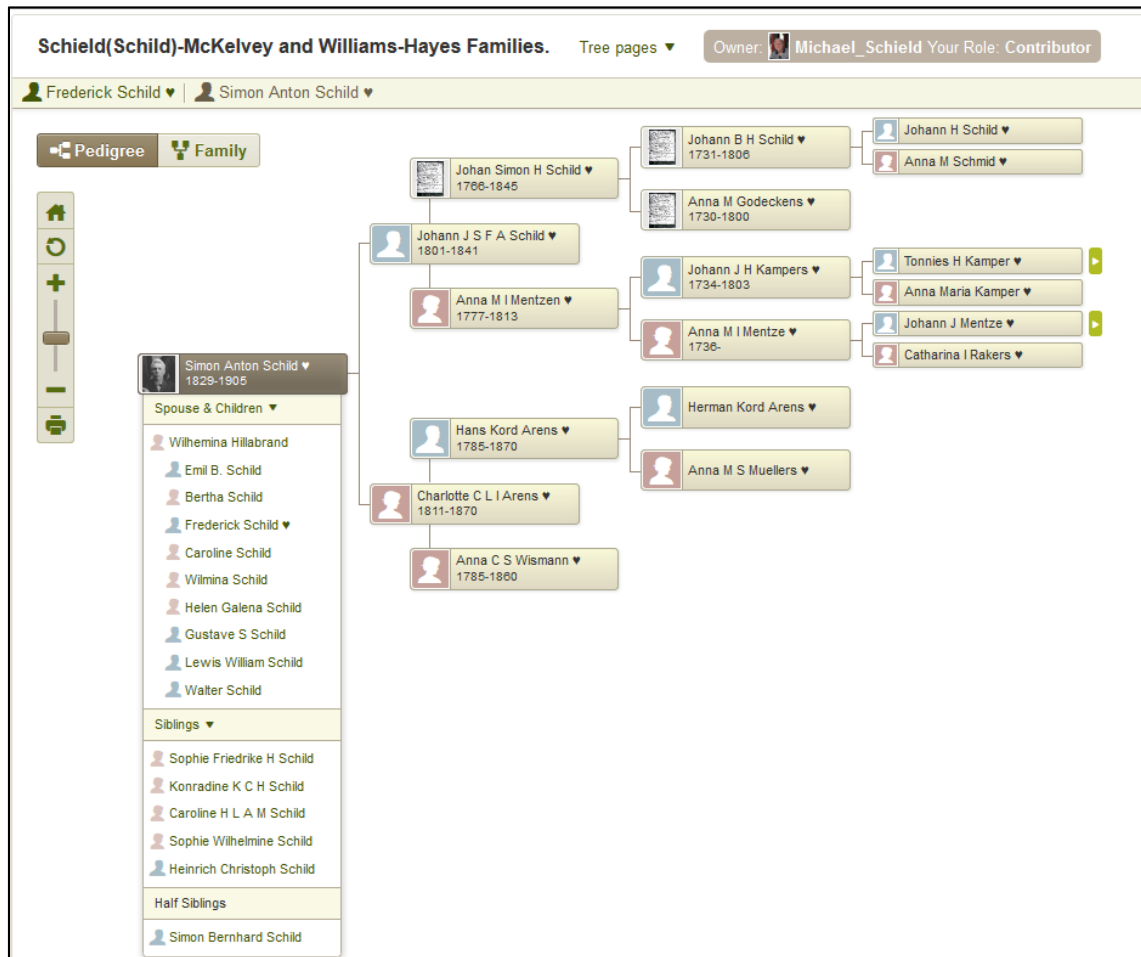

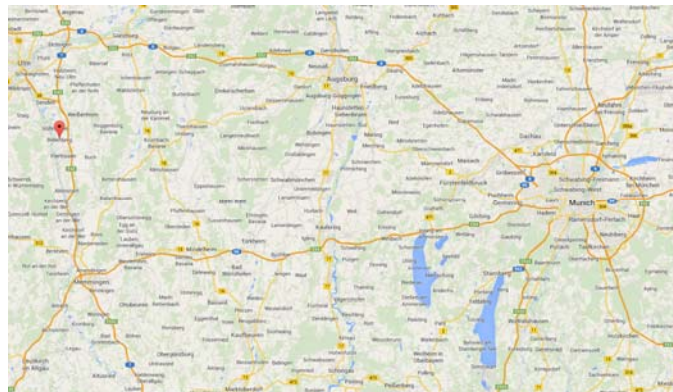

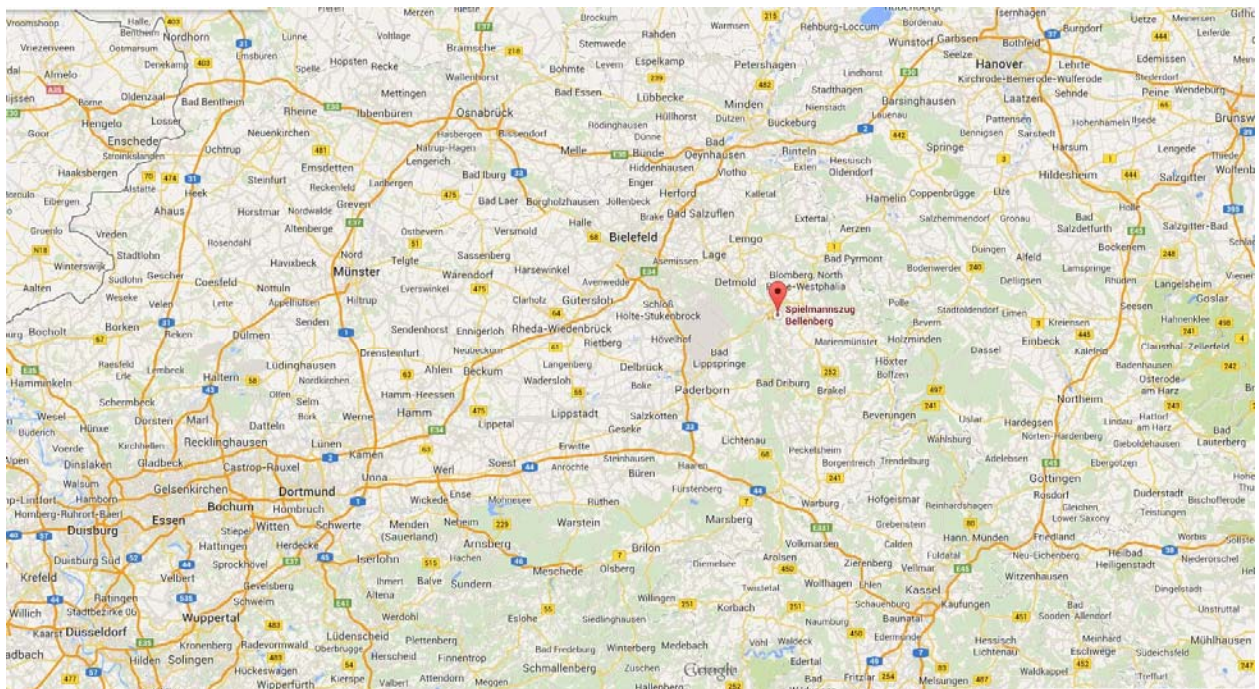
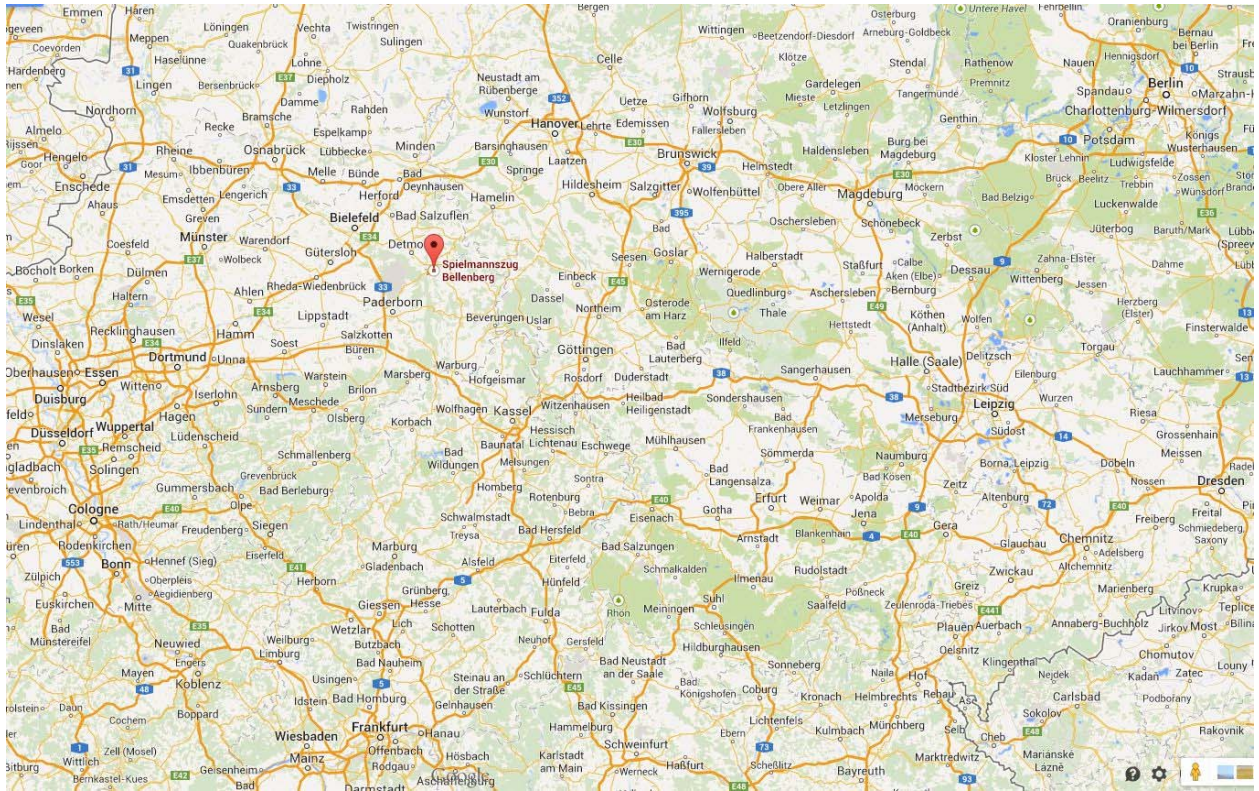


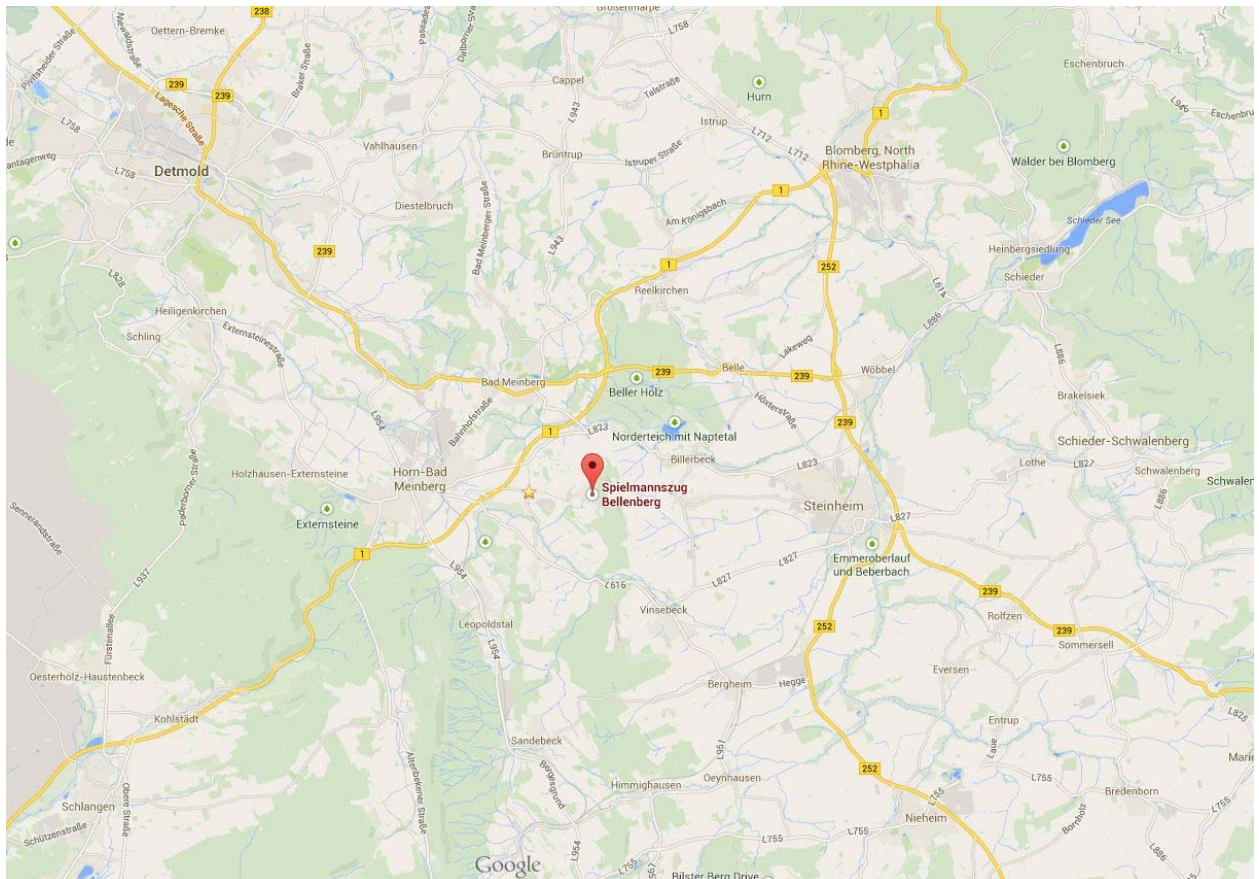
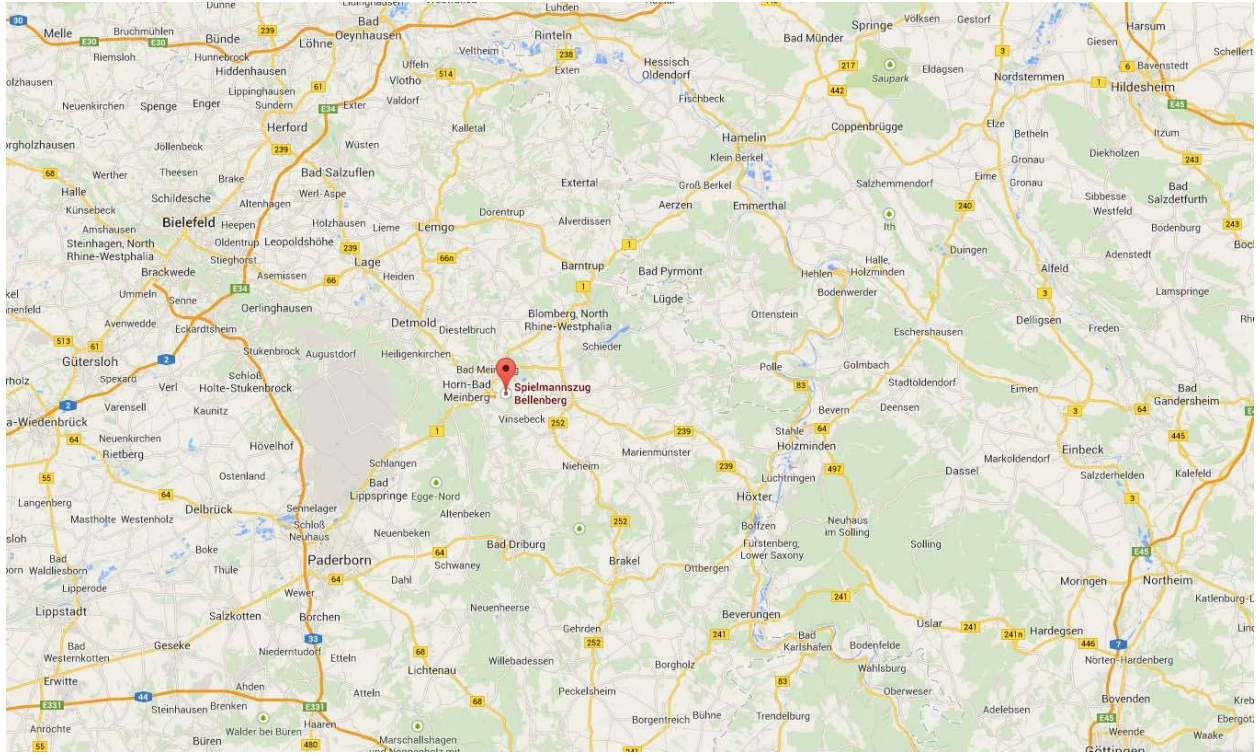


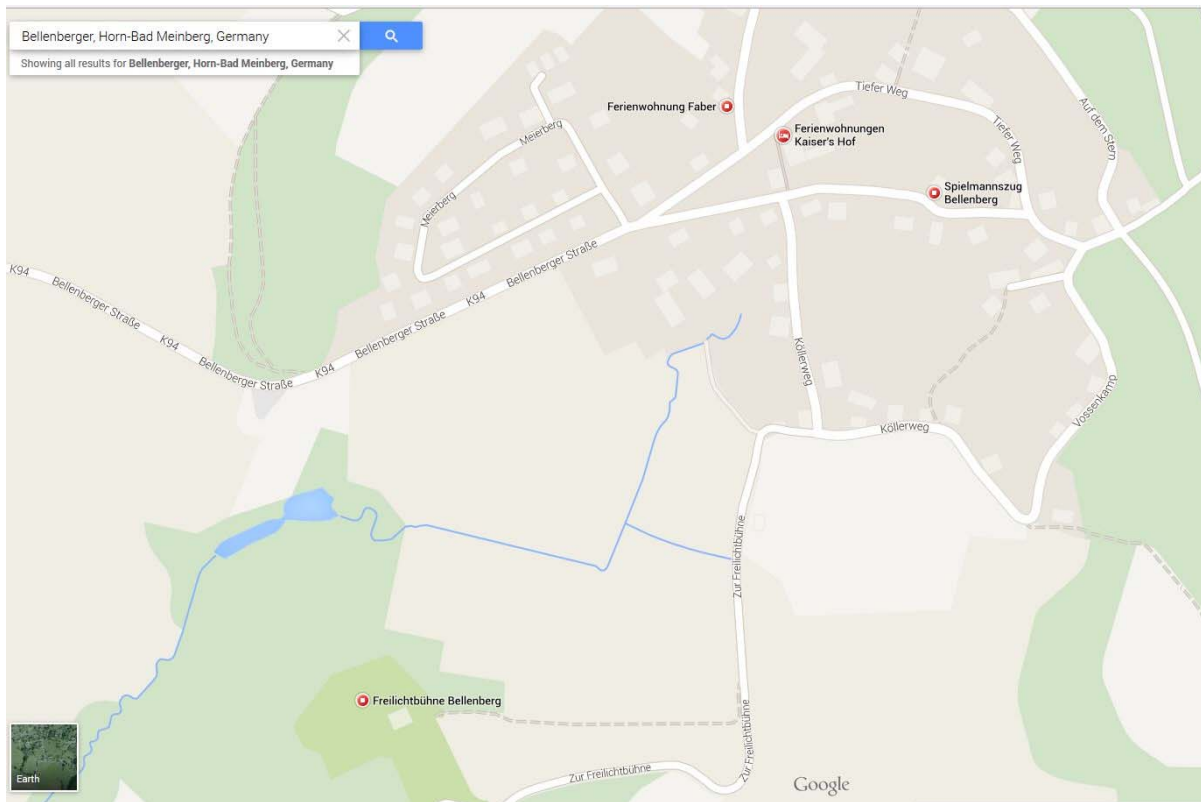
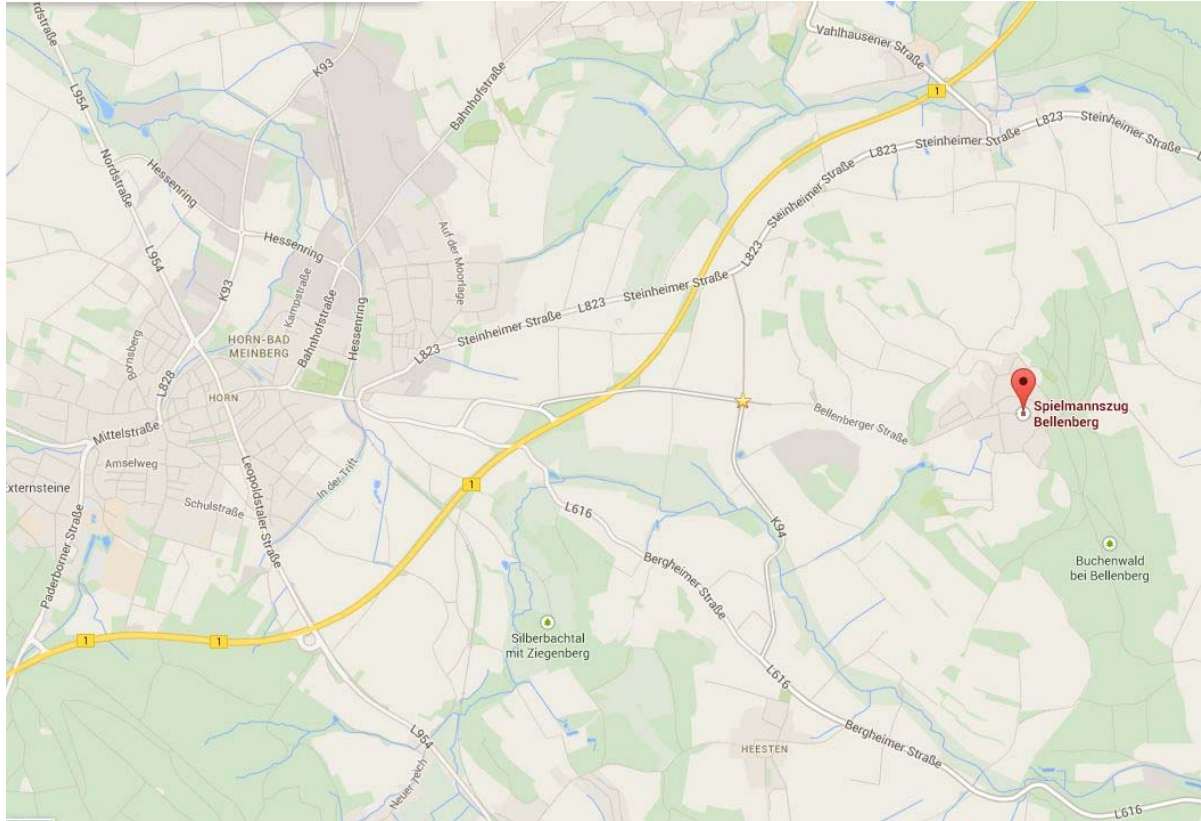






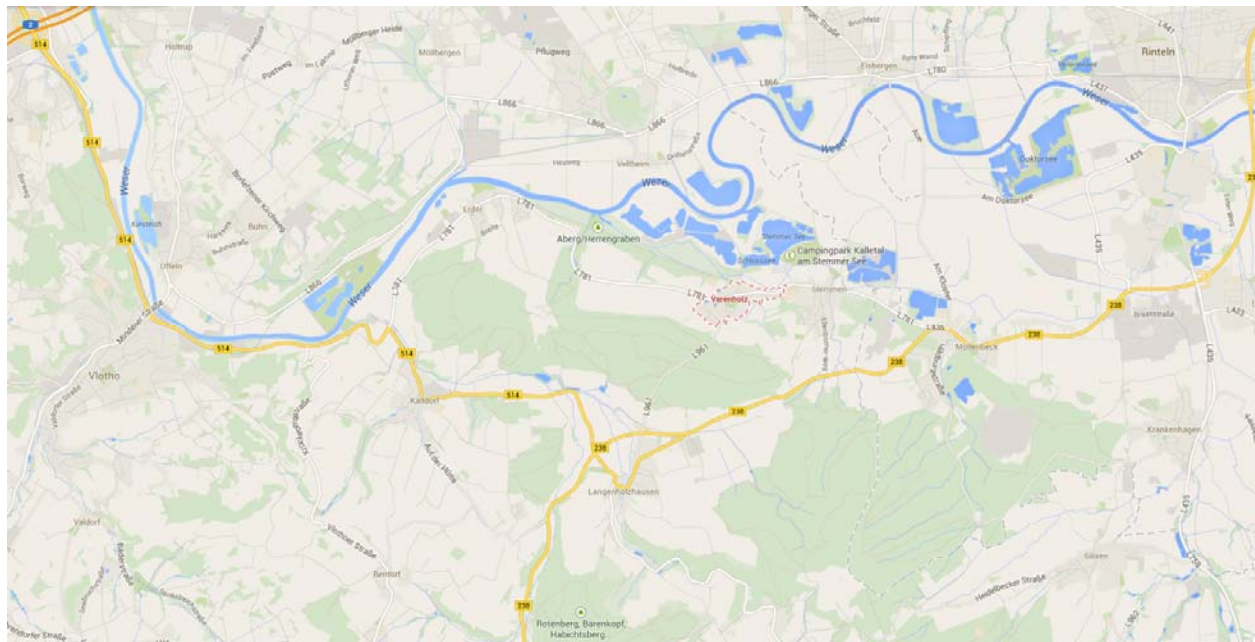
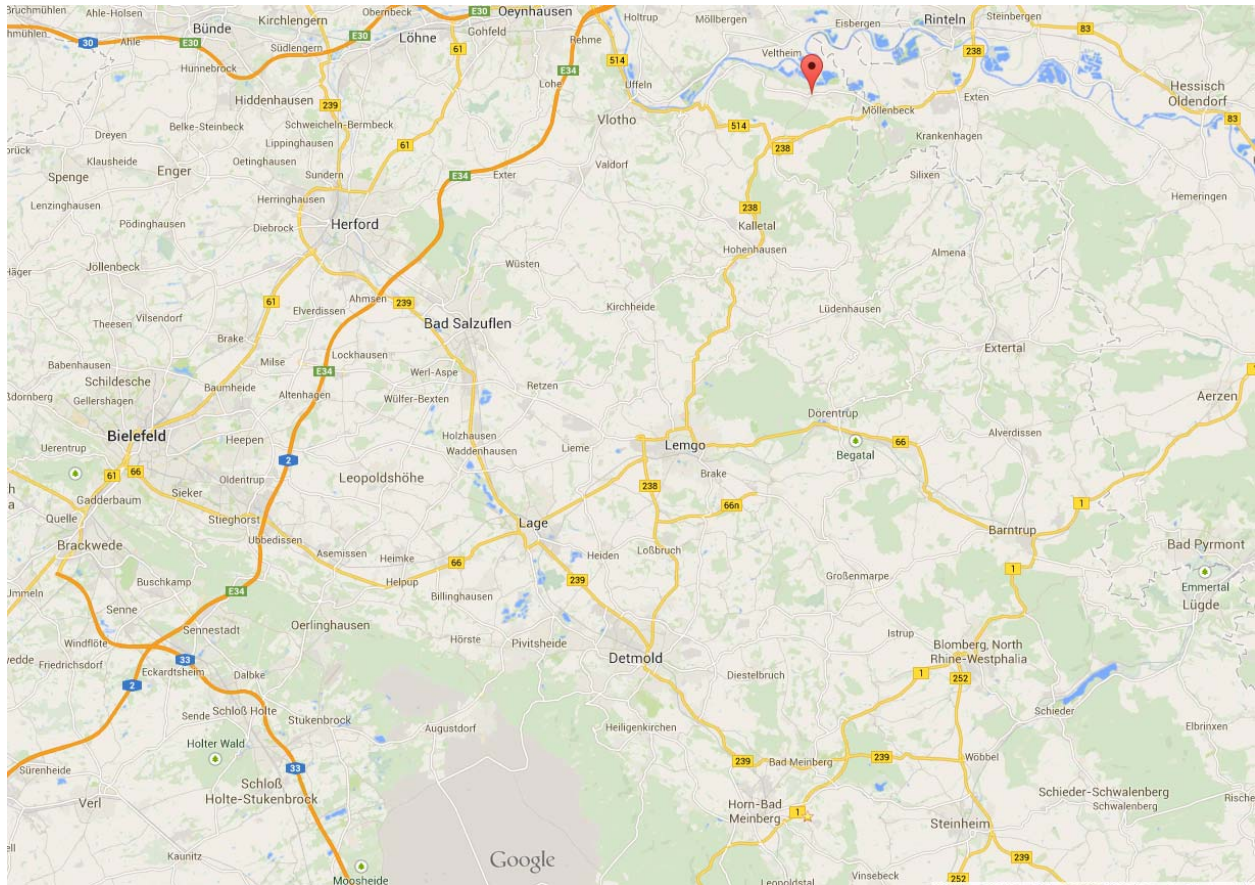




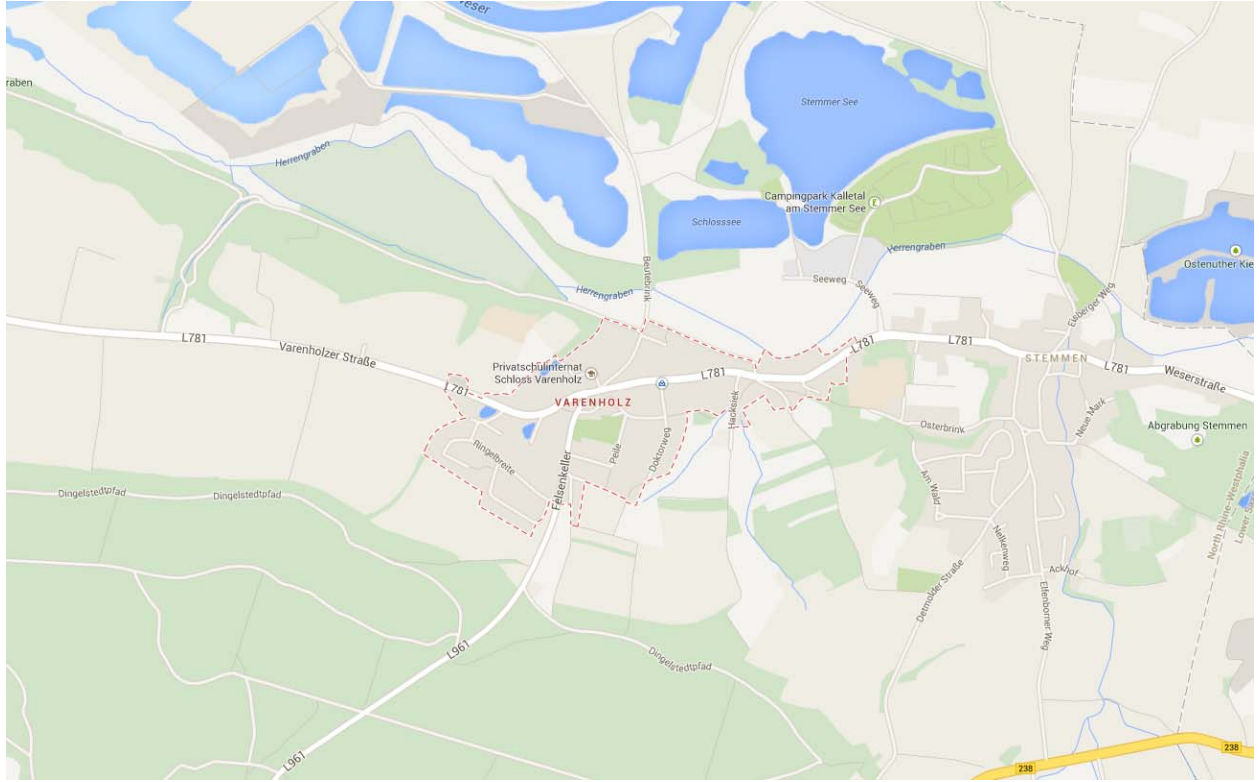


Maps of the Hillabrand family home in Varanholz, Lippe, Germany

Simon Anton's wife's birthplace in Varenholz, Germany – North of Bellenberg.

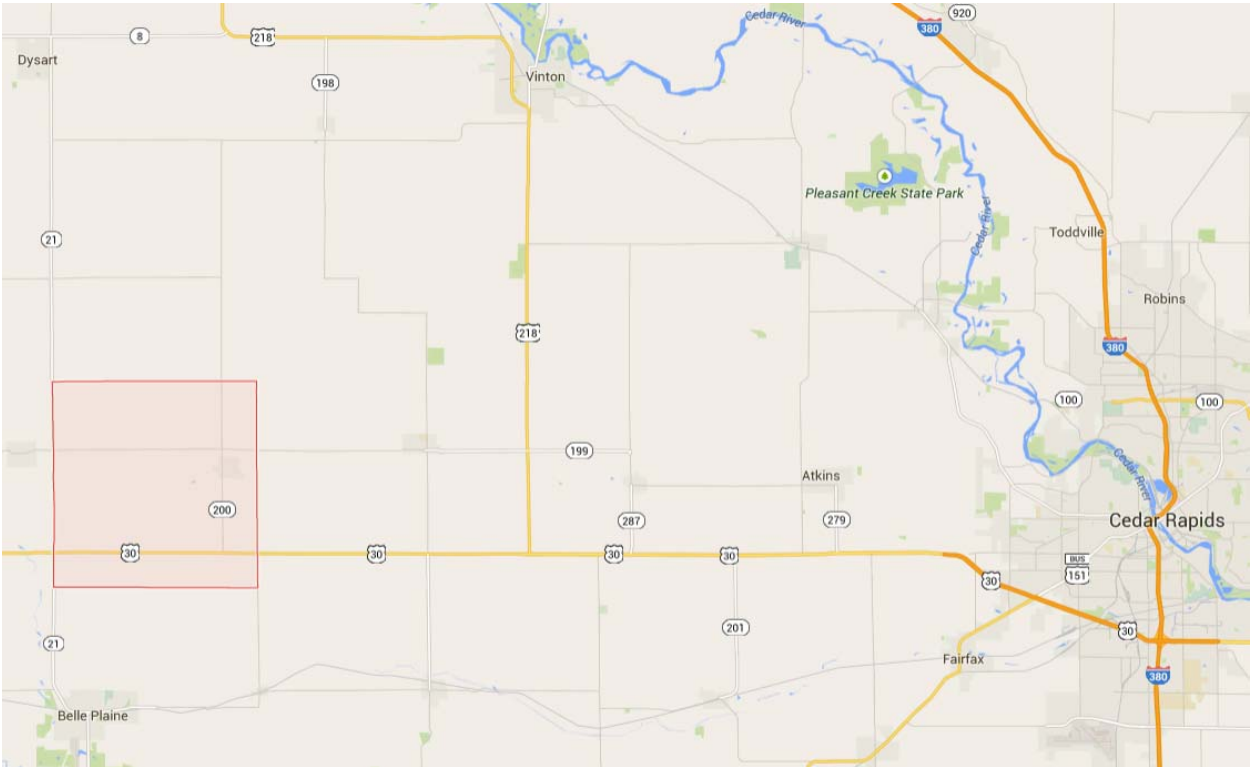


Maps of the Hillabrand family home in Varanholz, Lippe, Germany

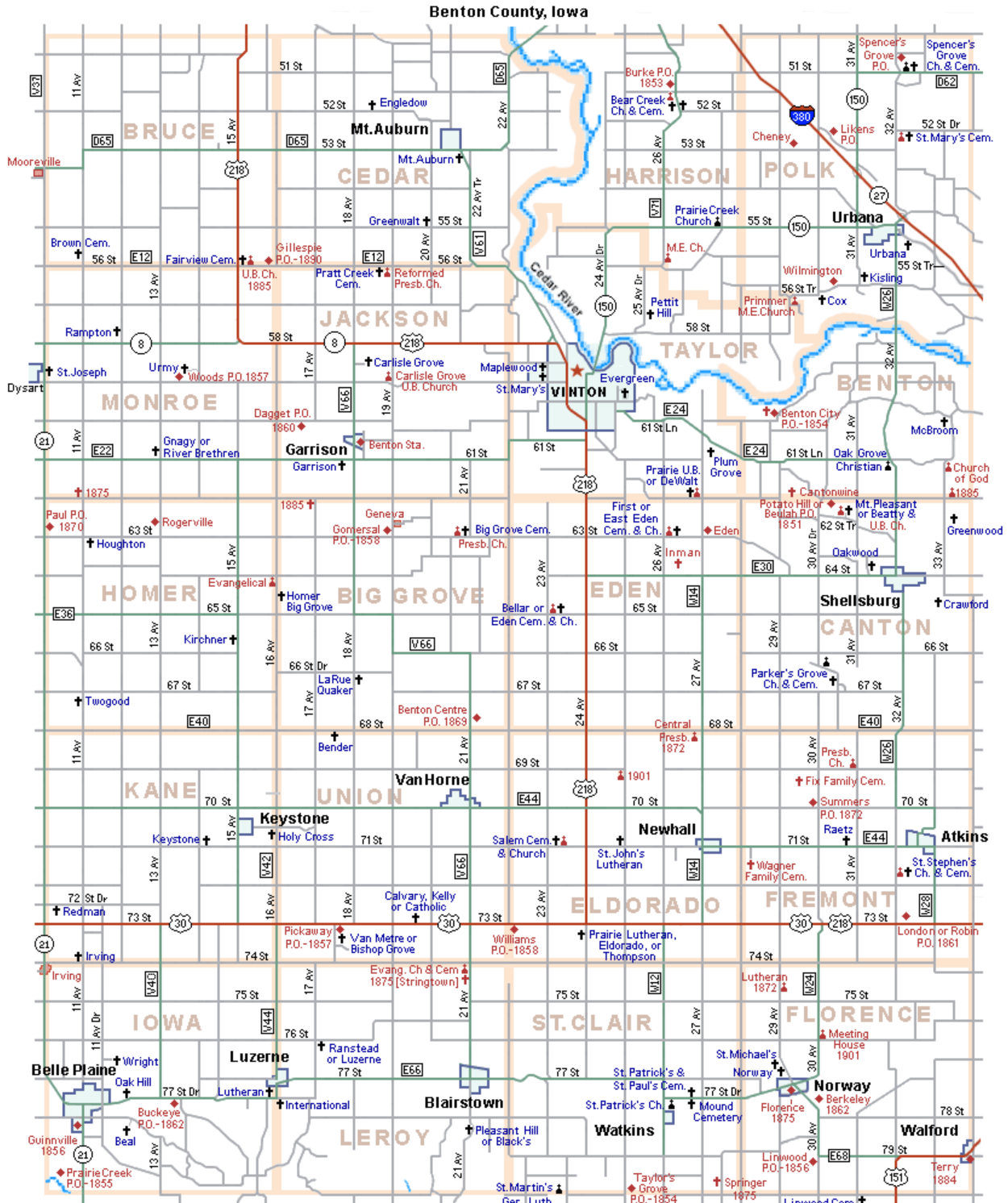


Maps of Simon Schild's Home in Kane Township, Benton County, Iowa

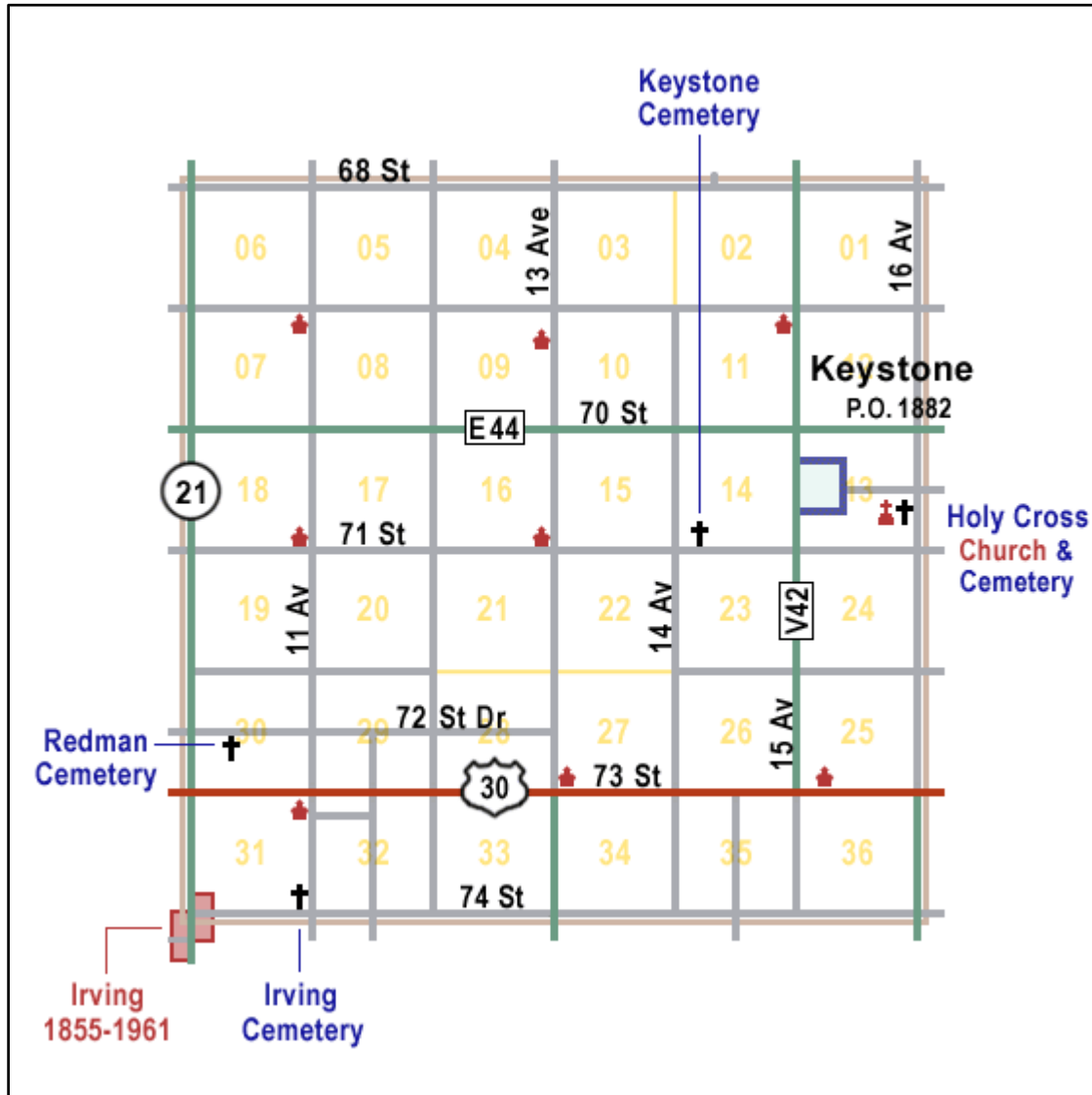

Maps of Simon Schild's Home in Kane Township, Benton County, Iowa

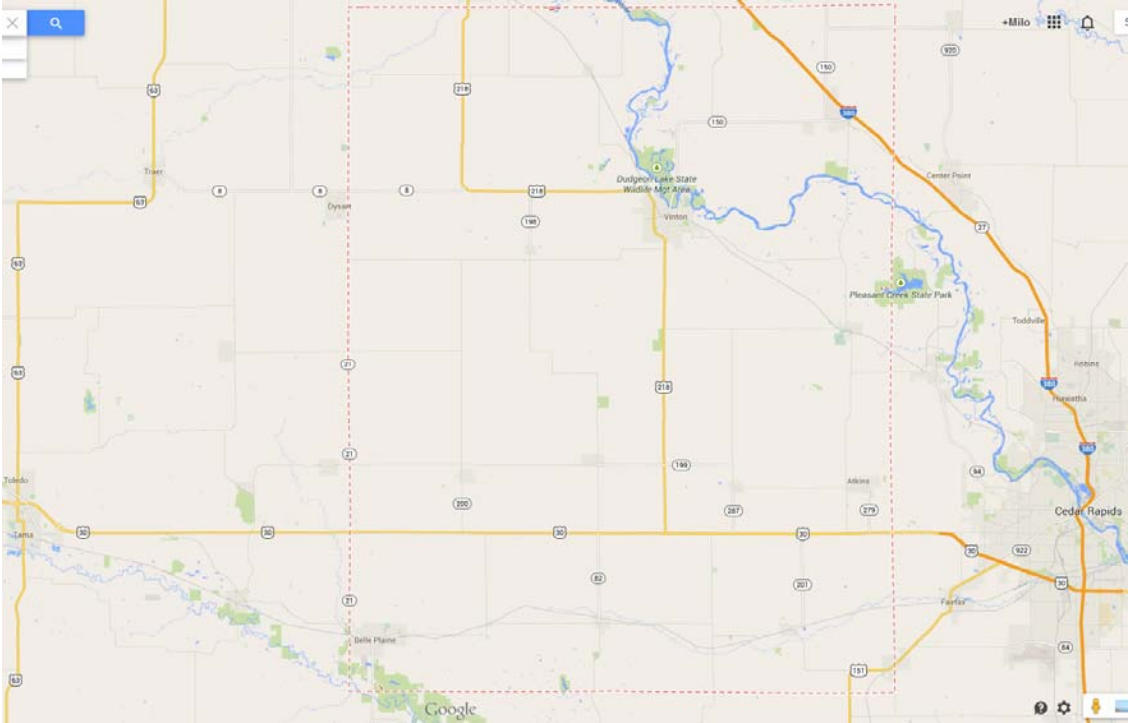

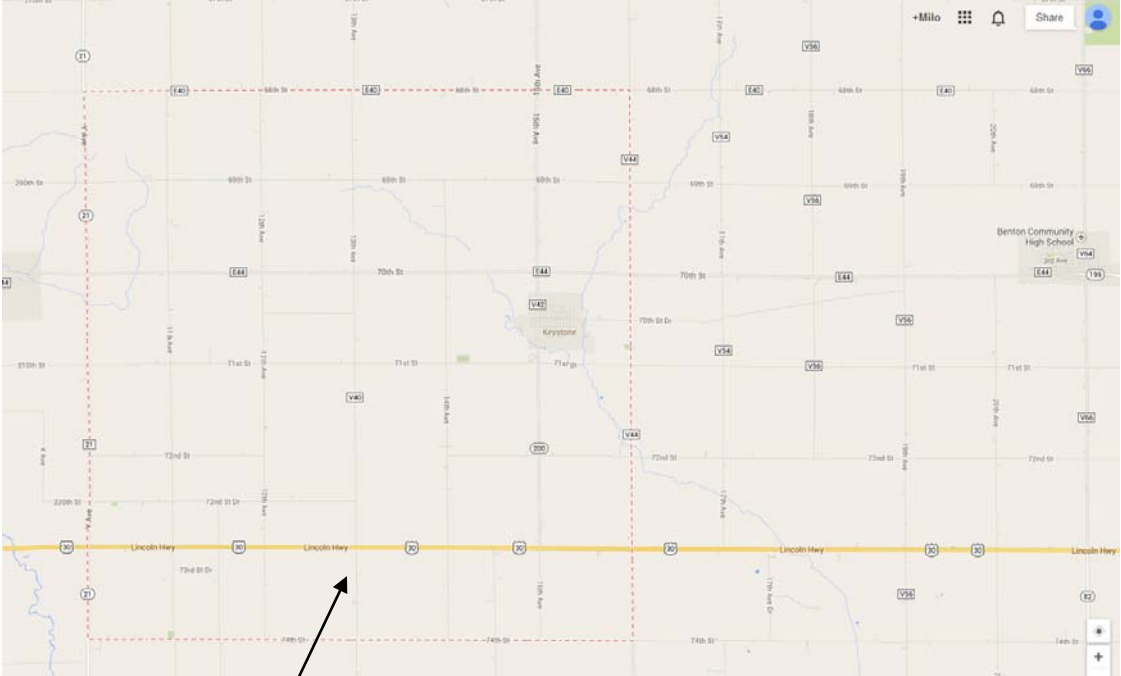
Simon Schild's land was just south of US 30 and just west of V40 (13th Avenue) in section 33.

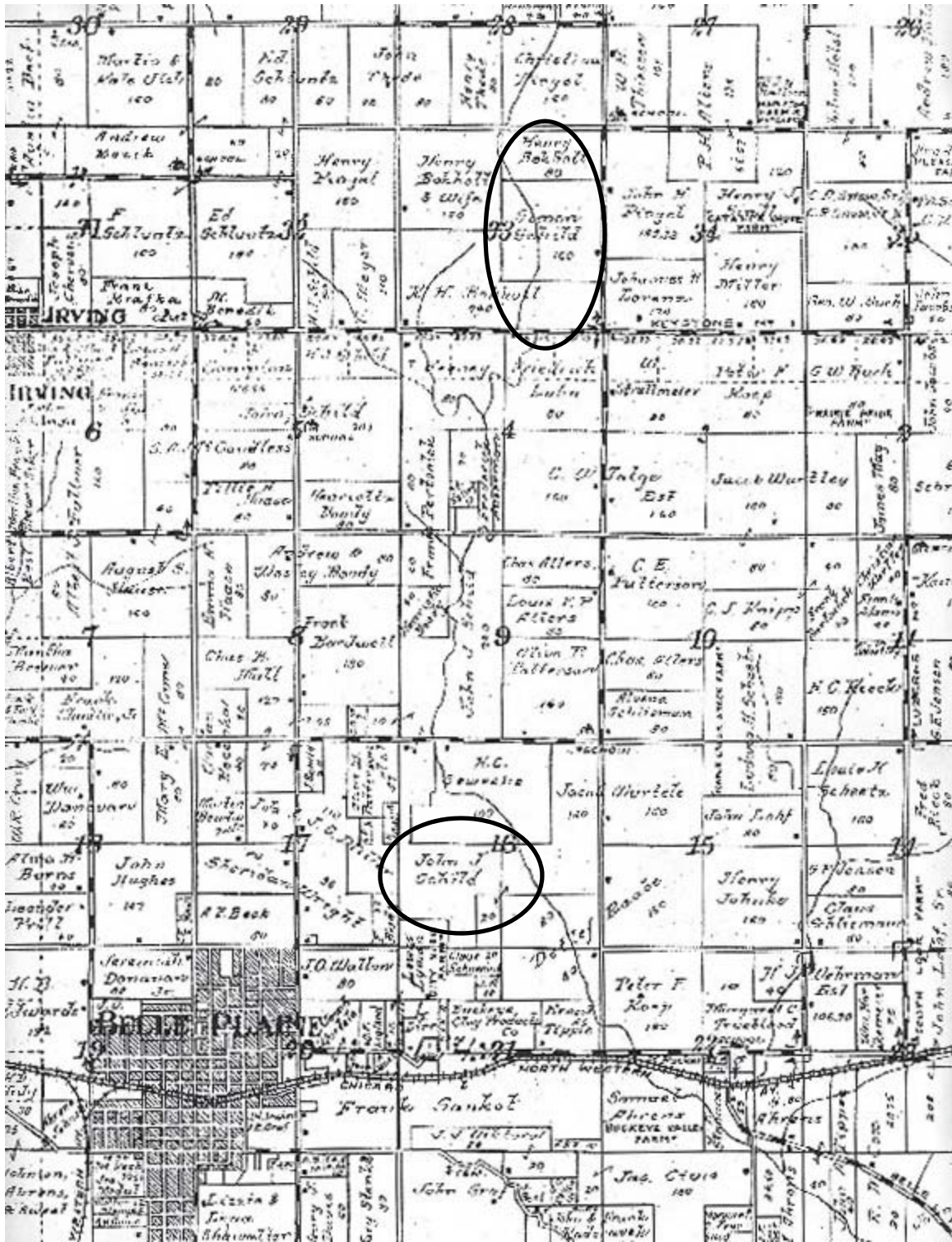
Google map of Kane Township in Benton County, Iowa



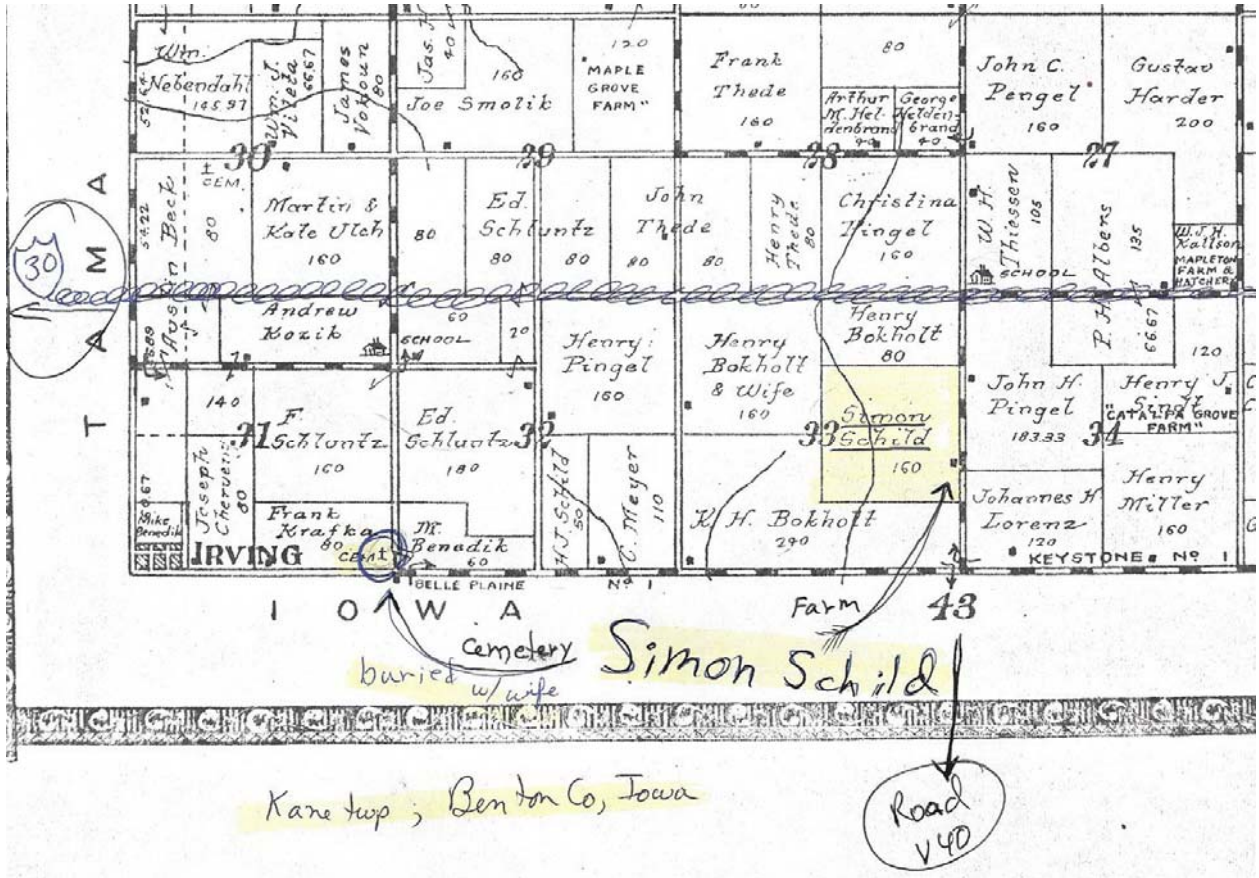
Simon Schild owned land in the section of Kane Township just south of US Highway 30 on the west side of V40.
