Posters

- Can be about any topic students choose within the general theme "Environment".
- Data used can be collected by students or be previously published by someone else. (If the data is published, the source must be cited in the poster).
 - Posters can be in any language.
- Posters must not contain any information about students or schools.
 - Posters from previous competitions are not allowed.
 - Posters must be the original design and creation of students.
- Must be two dimensional (one single sheet) and one-sided. Maximum size A1 (841 mm x 594 mm or 33.1 in x 23.4 in). Maximum file size is 2 MB.
- All entries become the property of the International Statistical Institute (ISI) and can not be returned.
- By submitting a poster, students give permission for their work to be displayed at various ISI conferences, special events, in publications and promotional material, and in electronic format on the Internet.
