



US-ISLP Poster Competition 2010-2011 Rules

Who can take part?

- Teams of 1-5 students for the US competition
 [Teams of 2-3 for the international competition]
- Two divisions:
 - students born in 1995 and younger
 - students born in 1992 and younger
- Students may only take part in one team and make one poster
- Posters must be submitted by teachers to the US country coordinator

- Free entry

When?

- National competitions
 - Submit poster to US ISLP country coordinator
 National winners announced
 April 30, 2011
 31st May 2011
 - Judges may fail to award winners if poster quality is lacking.
- International competition
 - International winners informed 30th July 2011
 - Prizes awarded at 58th ISI World Statistics Congress 2011 in Dublin

Posters

- Can be about any topic students choose within the general theme Environment.
- Data used can be collected by students or previously published by someone else.
 (If the data is published, the source must be cited in the poster).
- Posters can be in any language.
- Posters must not contain any information about students or schools.
- Posters from previous competitions are not allowed.
 Posters can be enrolled simultaneously in the ASA and US-ISLP competitions.
- Posters must be the original design and creation of students.
- Must be two dimensional (one single sheet) and one-sided. Maximum size A1 (841 mm x 594 mm or 33.1 in x 23.4 in).
- All entries become the property of the ISI and cannot be returned.
- By submitting a poster, students give permission for their work to be displayed at various ISI conferences, special events, in publications and promotional material, and in electronic format on the internet.

US posters can be submitted via a digital image. Maximum file size is 5 MB. Submit high-quality digital photos of posters to Schield@Augsburg.edu
