
Young-Earth Creation


Idea: Earth was created less than 10,000 years ago.


Young-earth creation agrees with a literal reading of Genesis which holds that God created everything in its present form in seven 24-hour days.

- Darwin's theory of evolution













'Billions of years' (distant starlight, radioactive decay) versus 'Thousand of years' (Bible taken literally). This is a big difference: a factor of a million! This is the difference between 1 inch and 16 miles.

Percentage of US adults who may uphold "young-earth": 15% of those who are secular; 27% of college grads 32% of mainline Protestants; 70% of Evangelicals

Theories Predicting Repeatable Things

- Testable, confirmable, may allow lab manipulation
- Theories of motion, light, heat, electricity, genetics
- Theories of gravity, special and general relativity

Theories Explain Unrepeatable Origins: Disputable

- Assumptions about conditions at distant times/places Applicability of our laws/theories to those times/places Origin of the universe (Big Bang)
- Origin of life (spontaneous generation)
- Origin of species (Darwin's theory of evolution)

Evolutionists are really exercising their imaginations ... as they come up with their origin-of-life theories.

A million-dollar Origin of Life Prize is offered for "proposing a highly plausible mechanism for the spontaneous rise of genetic instructions in nature sufficient to give rise to life."

Atheist Anthony Flew became a theist because the more science learned, the bigger the origin of life problem became. See Flew's "There Is a God." Flew now calls for teaching intelligent design in schools.

Evolution: The Missing Links

According to Charles Darwin:

- "the distinctness of specific forms and their not being blended together by innumerable transitional links is *a very obvious difficulty*."
- "Geological research has ... done *scarcely anything* in breaking the distinction between species by connecting them together." (Denton, p. 56 and 58).
- Denton: By the theory of evolution, innumerable transitional forms must have existed. Why do we not find them [the missing links]?"

Assumptions are Arbitrary: Arbitrary = Optional


Arbitrary: contingent solely upon one's discretion E.g., *an arbitrary decision*.


Science **cannot** test claims about unrepeatable origins. Requiring a naturalistic explanation is arbitrary.


Two different assumptions:

- 1. Religious: Accuracy of the bible taken literally
- 2. Scientific: Everything has a natural explanation.
- Science **cannot** say the religious assumption is false.

Assumptions are Arbitrary Arbitrary = Optional

Arbitrary: contingent solely upon one's discretion E.g., *an arbitrary decision*.

Modern philosophy holds that human choices involving ideas are arbitrary:

- Numbers are arbitrary. XVII vs. 17
- Words are arbitrary: dog vs. canine
- Language is arbitrary: English vs. Chinese
- Concepts are arbitrary: Freedom, Justice, Safety
- Theories are arbitrary: Global warming
- So, assumptions are arbitrary: God vs. Nature

Different Assumptions Evolution vs. Adaptation




Them Dry Bones

One set of bones, two interpretations. How can two paleontologists, digging the same dinosaur fossil in the field, reach opposite conclusions?

The answer: starting points. Fossils don't come with labels. We must begin with assumptions! But which is correct?







Conclusion

Modern philosophy: Assumptions are arbitrary. Generalizations (universals) cannot be challenged.

- So, all differences in beliefs that are based on different assumptions cannot be challenged.
- Prediction: United action by young-earth creationists and intelligent designers will transform US school education in science concerning evolution.
