In 2010, the Math Assoc. of America (MAA) and the National Numeracy Network (NNN) did a joint preliminary survey on the quantitative literacy courses at US four-year colleges.

The survey team will handle the data analysis and writing a summary paper that would be submitted for publication in the NNN journal: Numeracy.
